Digestive motility = the movement and breakdown of food by the digestive system. The nervous system inside your gut is responsible for the coordination of motility. When these gut-nerves falter or fail, endless digestive symptoms may result landing many in a hospital bed, or housebound for months.

Called, ‘gastroparesis’ – gastro = stomach, + paresis = weakness or paralysis – it is also known as delayed gastric emptying, and represents the most common of the more severe digestive motility problems. Five million Americans have gastroparesis. Across North America, millions suffer with upper digestive distress related to a gut motility disturbance which includes acid reflux, dyspepsia or gastroparesis.

Chances are you know someone who is suffering.

Damage to the nerves within the gut may be the result of other diseases such as diabetes, Parkinson's disease, or AIDS, or may even result from food poisoning. Yet, for the majority of sufferers, no known medical cause can be found. Of this group, most are young women who may be mistakenly diagnosed with an eating disorder. For some, it can take years to get properly diagnosed.
